• What to Bring

- It is absolutely required you bring your provided pair of safety glasses/side shields. You cannot enter the "Pits" w/out glasses.
- Money for additional food (meals provided on both days)
- Snacks or drinks if you don't want to pay for them
- Your cell phone
 - If we call you, you are expected to answer. We will only call you if it is urgent
 - It is NOT for sitting and playing games all day in the stands; if your battery is dead, you are using it wrong. Bring a battery pack if you know you will need it.

• Competition Jobs

- Drive Team
 - Control the robot during matches. Includes driver, operator, and human player
- Pit crew
 - Make repairs to the robot between matches
 - Talk to judges
- Head Scouts
 - Handle the organization of scouting data
 - Manage scouts
 - Create a pick list on Friday night
 - Representative for alliance selection
- Scouts
 - Be in the stands during your shift, taking scouting data
- 818 Squad
 - Represent Team 818 positively throughout the event

• Dress Code

- Team Shirt
- Blue or black pants, (jeans recommended) Cargo, or jean shorts of acceptable length (knee length)
- Close-toed shoes; **NO sandals or flip-flops**
- Any reasonable team spirit wear *If you're unsure if it's reasonable, ask
